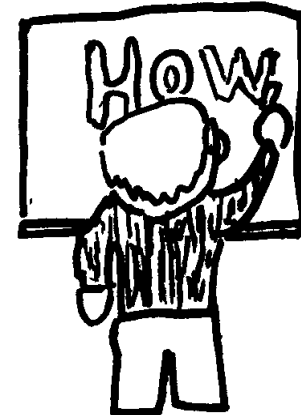
Training

SPC Training on Plan Requirements

- MOE training sessions
- SPC meetings

Training on Tools

- expertise within the SPC
- external expertise (guest speakers)



Getting started on the Plan

Plan Development *Road Map* (Early Fall)

Consultation

- municipal involvement/input
- other stakeholder consultations (what types of significant threats?)
- public /landowner consultation

Overall Approach

- moderate and low threats
- risk management plans
- prohibition



Municipal Involvement

Drafting of Policy Options for SPC consideration

- staff “technical” team draft options
- municipal involvement with staff team (from key municipalities)
- sharing of ideas among SPCs

Discussion Papers on Policy Options

- circulated/presented to municipalities

Five Municipal Working Groups

- provide input and comments on drafts

Regional planning workshops

- Meeting 1: introduce planning requirements/seek input on path forward
- Later meetings: present options and gather feedback
