# *Draft Proposed Assessment Report*

Post Notice of draft proposed in at least 1 newspaper

Posting in newspapers across region

Post draft proposed on website

Posting draft proposed on website

Provide notice to municipalities, FN, Great Lakes agencies

Providing notice, DVD (for municipalities hard copy of text, applicable system maps)

Make drafts available in public locations

Municipalities, CAs –hard copy and DVDs

Hold at least 1 meeting per SPA no sooner than 21 days after posting

6 meetings to be scheduled (1 per SPA, 2 in Kawartha-Haliburton)

Comment period closes 35 days or more after posting

Proposing 37 days

Landowner notification

Letters to be sent by lead on behalf of SPC

Comments submitted to SPC

Comments submitted to SPC through lead SPA

In addition to public & municipal comments, MOE and SPA and other agencies may comment

In-house editing will occur during this period (okay as long as it does not affect intent/landowners affected)

SPC revises documents based on comments received

Provide copy of AR to municipalities & FN

30 day comment period

Comments to be sent to SPA

Directed to lead SPA on behalf of all SPAs (as with Terms of Reference)

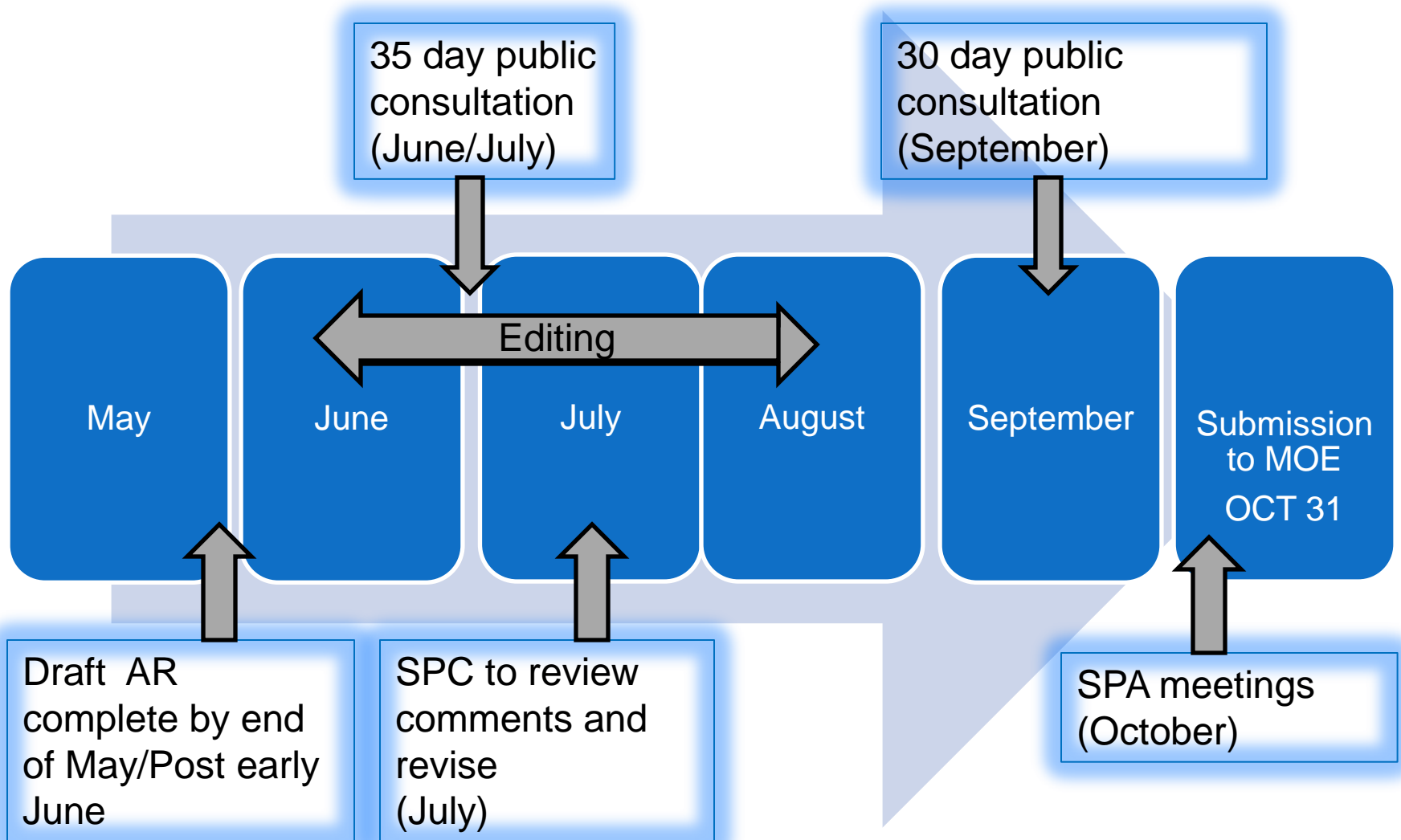
SPAs can make comments

Lead SPA submits ARs to MOE on behalf of all SPAs (as with Terms of Reference) with SPA comments, other comments received, and summary of public consultation
