RE: Summaries of Pre-Consultation Feedback

The feedback from the pre-consultation process related to 13 of the 21 prescribed drinking water threats has been reviewed and summarized by staff. A summary document has been prepared for each group of policies as given in the table below. Further, a support document entitled “How to Read this Document” has also been prepared to describe the layout of the summaries. The summary documents and support document will be reviewed with SPC members on January 19th.

Each document summarizes the feedback received from municipalities, Source Protection Authorities, Conservation Authorities, provincial ministries, and other implementing bodies during the pre-consultation period. Additional comments and clarifications from staff are also given.

All comments that would result in a change of policy approach or a consequential change in policy wording are highlighted for a decision by the Source Protection Committee. In some cases, recommendations are simply to “consider” a given comment or set of options.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1)** Approve the recommendations and consider the suggestions laid out in the pre-consultation summary documents for incorporation into the *draft* source protection plans.
- 2)** Approve the feedback given in the pre-consultation summary documents for inclusion in the response document being prepared for TCC SPR municipalities.
