In the last quarter (March – May 2010), the Source Protection Committee held its meetings in Peterborough, Norwood, Curve Lake First Nation and Bridgenorth, including one meeting that spanned two days. We continue to invite municipal representatives from the communities we visit to attend our meetings to provide greetings from their council and a brief overview of their area.

This last quarter has been a tremendously busy one – for the committee and for staff. The final drafts of the consultant studies, outlined in my previous Quarterly Reports, are now complete and the findings have been incorporated into the draft Proposed Assessment Reports for the region. The Source Protection Committee is now prepared to post the draft reports for public consultation.

The reports:

- Draft Proposed Trent Assessment Report (for the Crowe Valley, Kawartha-Haliburton, Lower Trent, and Otonabee-Peterborough Source Protection Areas)
- Draft Proposed Ganaraska Assessment Report (for the Ganaraska Region Source Protection Area)

will be posted on the Trent Conservation Coalition website: www.trentsourceprotection.on.ca on June 2, 2010. Ads will be placed in local newspapers and notification will be sent to local municipalities, First Nations, agencies responsible for implementing Great Lakes policies and programs, neighbouring source protection regions, and property owners, businesses, organizations and tenants that may be engaged in activities identified as a significant threat to drinking water. Local municipalities will also receive a printed copy of the report and maps

applicable to their drinking water system; First Nations communities will receive a printed copy of the report as well. DVDs of the reports will be made available to the public at Conservation Authority and Municipal offices throughout the source protection region. Affected property owners/tenants will receive a comment form and stamped envelope to encourage feedback on the findings of the reports. The deadline for comments on this draft is July 9th, following the public meetings identified below.


Meetings are scheduled from 3 PM to 8 PM with presentations at approximately 3:30 PM and 6:30 PM.
